APPLICATION PROCESS:

- ❑ **APPLICATION:** Complete and submit the Northern Lakes College application form (available at all Northern Lakes College locations and on the college website).
- ❑ **APPLICANTS** for the Apprenticeship program must be registered with Alberta Apprenticeship. Application forms can be downloaded from the Alberta Apprenticeship website, www.tradesecrets.org.
- ❑ **ACCEPTANCE:** Applicants who are verified through the Alberta Apprenticeship will be accepted and offered a space in the next available offering of the program. When spaces are full, they will be placed on a waitlist. Applicants will be accepted in the order of "first qualified, first served." They will receive a letter informing them of their acceptance status.
- ❑ **FUNDING:** Applicants are encouraged to check on funding options early (**Minimum of 2 months prior to program start date**). Counsellors can assist with identifying funding options and applying for sponsorship of fees and living costs.
- ❑ **REGISTRATION:** Before the start date of the program, accepted applicants will receive information about registration dates, times, locations and other information to assist them.
