

Guidelines:

Participants in research projects have the following rights:

1. to consent to participation without coercion;
2. to be fully informed about the project, except under special circumstances;
3. to be provided with opportunity to assess risk;
4. to withdraw from the research without penalty of any kind (including loss of agreed upon monetary reimbursement or other incentives);
5. to be fully informed of the degree of anonymity;
6. to have access to the research results.
