 - A. Administrative materials

- B. Curriculum materials
- C. Teaching materials and equipment
- D. Instructional by-products
- E. Teaching/learning resources and learning objects
- F. Professional, technical and artistic works
- G. Research
- H. Any other technology or works
- 2. Specific relationships will be clearly identified in any detailed agreements and supplementary documents that are developed within this framework.
- 3. There will be procedures written that discuss the creation of works during the normal course of employment, outside employment and during paid leave.
