Description of the Logo Elements: In keeping with Northern Lakes College's traditional values, the eagle is symbolic of strength and wisdom. From great heights, the eagle will soar with wings spread wide expressing the courage and freedom of students to 'start here and go anywhere'. The soft blue circle represents the beautiful lakes in our communities and the vibrant green signifies the vast forests across the north.
