Guidelines:

The College provides accommodations to students with documented disabilities in a manner that respects their dignity by ensuring equal access to education in accordance with the Alberta Human Rights Act and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms.

The College encourages full participation of students with disabilities by removing barriers to education and services by creating accessible facilities, services and programs. Accommodation is provided in such a way that integration and full participation of persons with disabilities is encouraged.

Students with disabilities have a responsibility to self-disclose their formal diagnosis to the College in order to receive appropriate accommodations. Once the student has identified their need, the process becomes a shared responsibility with the College.
