# **HOW TO GUIDE:**

#### APPLYING FOR ALBERTA WORKS LEARNER INCOME SUPPORT SPONSORSHIP

## STEP 1: Begin by gathering all the information you will need. Use this checklist.

#### APPLICANT:

- Full Legal Name (on birth certificate)
- Date of Birth
- Social insurance Number
- Alberta Health Care Number
- Mailing Address
- Land Location (if using a box number)
- Line 150 from your most recent Income Tax assessment
- Indian registration Number (if applicable)
- What grade did you last complete in the K-12 system?
  - o What date did you begin/end in this grade?
- Employment:
  - o Name of most recent employer
  - o Date began work & date last worked
  - How many hours/week
  - o Rate of pay
  - If on EI (or have been within the last 5 years), you will need to know your payment amounts, and date of last payment
- # of kilometers from house to NLC campus (if you are residing outside of the community that campus is in)
- Any income you are receiving (such as, Income Support or child support)

#### IF MARRIED OR IN COMMON-LAW RELATIONSHIP:

- Full legal name
- Date of birth
- Social Insurance Number
- Alberta Health Care Number
- Line 150 from most recent Income Tax
- Indian Registration Number (if applicable)
- Employment:
  - Name of most recent employer
  - Date began work & date last worked
  - How many hours/week
  - Rate of pay
  - If on EI (or have been within the last 5 years), you will need to know your payment amounts, and date of last payment

#### IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN:

- Full legal name(s)
- Date of Birth
- Alberta Health Care Number
- Indian Registration Number (if applicable)
- Child Tax Amount
- If childcare will be required while you are in school:
  - o How many hours/month
  - Name of childcare provider
  - Phone number of childcare provider
  - o Amount/month
- If you are claiming as a single parent:
  - Full names of children
  - How many days/month are they in your care
  - Name of their other biological parent (if known)
  - Address of other biological parent (if known)

Are you currently working? Have you worked between 420 and 700 hours in the last 12 months?

If these apply to you, you <u>must</u> go to your nearest Alberta Works Office, and speak with an Employment Counsellor <u>before</u> applying for Learner Income Support Benefits. It is critical that you obtain a <u>Council to Leave Employment</u> <u>before</u> you quit a job to return to school. If you miss this step, you may not be eligible for funding

through this grant. Contact your nearest Service Canada Office or dial 1-800-206-7218 for more information.

# STEP 3: Click on 'Watch help videos'




Great! Now you know what to expect when you complete your online application.

# STEP 4: Click on 'Apply online'




# **Step 5: Log In or Create Account**

SIAMS is the Secure Identity & Access Management System for the Government of Alberta. You must have a user account in order to complete the online application.







# STEP 11: Sign and submit your 'Declaration' to NLC Student Records (Grouard)

You can take your documents to any NLC campus, and they will courier it to **Student Records, Grouard**.

Now it is our turn to add the school form. Once we attach a 'TRAINER PROVIDER FORM' to your declaration and send it to the LEARNER INCOME SUPPORT OFFICE for approval, you will get a confirmation note from NLC. Please read this letter for important information.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Do I have to live in Alberta to be eligible?

Yes. You must be a current resident of Alberta, attending one of Northern Lakes College's approved regional sites.

How will I find out if I got approved? The Learner Income Support Office will send you a letter by mail, using the mailing address you provided on your application.

Who can I call to find out if I am approved? Yes. You can call the Learner Income Support Office at 1-800-222-6485 (toll-free) or 780-427-3722 (Edmonton).

Can I find out myself online if I am approved? Yes. Log on to the portal to find out! https://myalbertasupports.humanservices.alberta.ca/CitizenPortal/application.do



**How long does it take to get approved?** It takes 8-10 weeks for your application to be processed from the time you submit your *declaraton* to Student Records in Step 8.

# What happens if I don't get approved?

# Can I get living expenses if I live on reserve?

Learner Income Support program does NOT provide living expenses to individuals living on reserve. Please speak to your Band for additional information.

# Can I get Learner Income Support while on EI?
