BRANCH #110 SLAVE LAKE LEGION BURSARY

The Branch #110 Slave Lake Legion has instituted a bursary for students who are Veterans, children, grandchildren or great-grandchildren of any veteran.

A Veteran is any person who is serving or who has honourably served in the Canadian Armed Forces, the Commonwealth or its wartime allies, or as a regular member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, or as a Peace Officer in a special duty area or on a special duty operation, or who has served in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime.

The bursary is granted at the end of February and is paid from the Branch #110 Poppy fund. It is limited to two (2) \$500 bursaries or the number of \$500 bursaries which may be accommodated by 10% of the amount in the poppy fund as of September 30th of the previous year, at the discretion of the board, based on applications received.

The student must be attending at least their second year of a program that covers two or more years towards a degree or diploma.

Each applicant must:

- Have a home address within Slave Lake or the surrounding area (Mitsue, Widewater, Canyon Creek, Red Earth and Wabasca)
- Be attending or have attended a post-secondary course of study during the current academic year, in pursuit of a diploma or degree, at least in second year or later.
- Show proof of attendance in the form of a Confirmation of Registration letter or form.
- Show proof of connection to the veteran using document such as discharge papers, record of service, birth certificates and marriage certificates.
- Write a brief description of how they are paying for their education and demonstrating financial need.

In order to be eligible to receive this bursary, your application form must be completed in full (both pages) and must be accompanied by the following:

- Proof of attendance in the form of a Confirmation of Registration letter or form
- Identification of the veteran using documents such as discharge papers, records of service etc.
- Proof of connection to the veteran using documents such as birth certificates and marriage certificates. A signed statement by someone known personally by a member of the branch executive board may be accepted as proof.
- Proof of home address

All application materials must be received at the Branch #110 Slave Lake Legion by **the last day of February in the Academic Year of application.**
