Guidelines:

- 1. The principle of 'first to come qualified, first-served' applies to all students who meet program admission requirements.
- 2. Admission requirements will be established in response to education and industry standards; meeting these admission requirements provides students with a reasonable opportunity to successfully complete the program. Admissions standards will be set by individual programs and approved by the Deans' Council.
- 3. The College recognizes the importance of each student having a financial plan and resources in place as a critical success factor in program completion. As such, it is acknowledged that students are responsible for making their own arrangements for funding for their tuition and other fees incurred.
- 4. Admission to oversubscribed programs may be limited if resources are not available to create new spaces in a timely manner.

5.	The College reserves the right to determine program delivery sites based on anticipated enrollment numbers; resources for undersubscribed locations in particular may be re-allocated to locations with high demand.
