Title: Delegation of Authority – Programs and Services

Policy Statement:

The Board of Governors delegates that the President has the authority to initiate, modify, suspend, or terminate College programs and services within the following executive limitations:

- 1. Academic programs and services should be delivered as directly as feasible and will be developed in a supported distance learning model as much as possible.
- 2. Termination of programs and services in one program area will not directly result in campus closure.
- 3. Consultation with the Programs and Services Committee shall precede decisions which substantively change learner programs and services.
- 4. Modification of a program will not reduce transferability or accreditation wherever possible.
- 5. Consultation with the Academic Council shall precede decisions which substantively modify learner programs and services.
