





EARLY LEARNING AND CHILDCARE DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

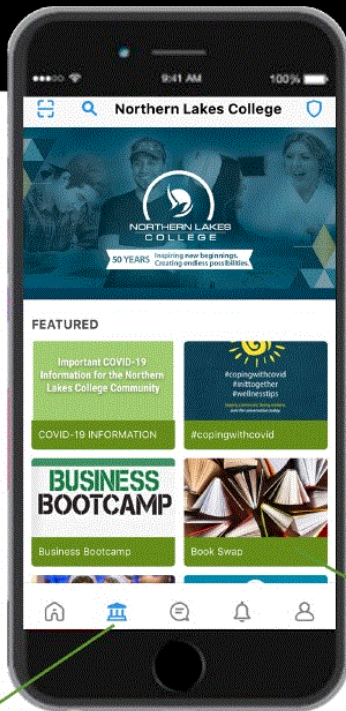

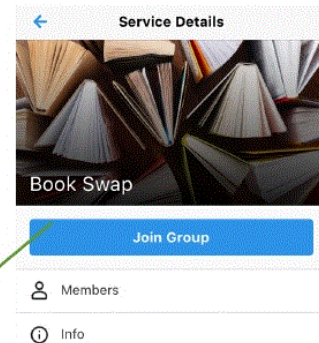
