STANDARD FIRST AID - LEVEL C CPR/AED

Course Code: FA001

Upon successfully completing this course, you will be awarded a nationally recognized certificate that is valid for 3 years. Recognized as First Aider II by Alberta Occupational Health and Safety, this course includes, treatment for choking, control of bleeding, treatment and prevention of shock, child and infant resuscitation, one adult and two-rescuer CPR. Fractures of the limbs, head and spinal injuries, eye injuries, burns, medical conditions, environmental injuries, wound care and secondary survey are also covered.

H2S ALIVE

Course Code: SA004

This course shows workers how to work safely in and around hydrogen sulphide (H2S) environments. It provides participants with the skills and knowledge to help them identify and detect H2S, mitigate the hazards of working in an H2S environment, and respond to an incident involving an H2S release. It includes both theory and practical application exercises. Upon successful completion of the course and examination with a minimum score of 70%, you will receive a Certificate of Completion that is valid for three years.

CANADIAN FIREARMS SAFETY COURSE (PAL)

Course Code: SA218

This course includes instruction on how to safely use, handle and store both firearms and ammunition. The Canadian Firearms Safety Course discusses the rules and regulations as well as the legal responsibilities and other duties required by firearm users and owners. This Certificate is valid for 5 years. Participants must be 18 years old at the time of training.


