IN-PERSON SAFETY COURSES

STANDARD FIRST AID - LEVEL C CPR/AED

This course is designed to comply with CSA Z1210-17 Standards. Over the duration of this course, participants receive education in Treatment for choking, control of bleeding, treatment and prevention of shock, child and infant resuscitation, one adult and two-rescuer CPR. Fractures of the limbs, head and spinal injuries, eye injuries, burns, medical conditions, environmental injuries, wound care and secondary survey are also covered. Upon successful completion, participants will receive a nationally recognized certificate that is valid for 3 years.

H2S ALIVE

This course shows workers how to work safely in and around hydrogen sulphide (H2S) environments. It provides participants with the skills and knowledge to help them identify and detect H2S, mitigate the hazards of working in an H2S environment, and respond to an incident involving an H2S release. It includes both theory and practical application exercises. Upon successful completion of the course and examination with a minimum score of 70%, you will receive a Certificate of Completion that is valid for three years.

CONFINED SPACE LEVEL III -ENTRY, MONITOR & RESCUE

Confined Space work involves some of the most critical hazards in the oil and gas industry. This training teaches participants to identify, understand and mitigate the potential hazards of working in restricted and confined spaces.

During this Confined Space Entry, Monitor & Rescue course each participant gets to experience mock situations that employees may be exposed to in the real world. Participants will be suited up and make their way through an actual tank to retrieve items to gain the most practical experience.

FALL PROTECTION

Falls from height are among the most common causes of serious work-related injuries and deaths in the workplace. This comprehensive fall protection training was developed to meet the highest standards for training in most Canadian jurisdictions using Canadian Standards Associations (CSA) Z259.

Designed to educate the worker in the planning, use, care, and implementation of common fall protection systems, it includes both theory and practical application exercises. Participants will engage in handson training activities, including inspecting, fitting, adjusting, and connecting fall protection systems and components.

CANADIAN FIREARMS SAFETY COURSE (PAL)

This course includes instruction on how to safely use, handle and store both firearms and ammunition. The Canadian Firearms Safety Course discusses the rules and regulations as well as the legal responsibilities and other duties required by firearm users and owners. Upon successful completion of the Canadian Firearms Safety Course and exam, students are awarded with their Non-Restricted PAL (Possession and Acquisition License.)

This Certificate is valid for 5 years. Participants must be 18 years old at the time of training.

ATV/UTV RIDER SAFETY

This course teaches participants how to safely and efficiently use an all-terrain vehicle (ATV). This course includes both classroom and practical training, with the greatest emphasis on operational skills and safety.



CHAINSAW OPERATOR

Participants receive education on chainsaw maintenance, handling, and operations through hands-on and theory portioned training. Learn everything from the basics to falling trees.

BABYSITTER BASICS

This course is for youth aged 11 to 15 years old. It teaches the new babysitter the necessary skills to provide care to children in a variety of situations. This course emphasizes safety rules, responding to emergencies, and developing leadership skills.

MOBILE ELEVATED WORK PLATFORM

This course is to provide guidelines for using mobile elevated work platforms safely and minimize any risk of injury to operators. If not operated safely, these platforms can cause incidents and cause severe injuries. This course complies with the CSA Standards and covers topics such as; legislation & regulatory requirements, equipment maintenance and inspections, types, features, and safety equipment.

FOOD SAFETY CERTIFICATION

Become a certified Food handler today! Over the duration of this course participants learn everything from food-borne illnesses, allergy management, cleaning, and equipment maintenance. Participants also learn kitchen hygiene, storing of ingredients, serving safe food and temperature controls.

CLASS 7 DRIVER'S PREPARATION

Over the duration of this course, participants learn the basic driving rules, traffic signs/ signals, and safe operations of a motor vehicle. Work through described situations, practice tests and guizzes to feel more prepared for the Class 7 examination.

SKID-STEER OPERATOR **CERTIFICATION**

Learn how to operate machinery safely through classroom theory and practical components. Participants learn about safe operating procedures, maintenance, safety regulations and hazard identifiers.
