Policy Statement:

The Board of Governors recognizes public participation is a critical component of the development, growth, and future of Northern Lakes College. The Board of Governors will support such participation through the authorization of honoraria paid to all participants, in accordance with the honoraria schedules.

Objective:	N/A
Guidelines:	1. Honoraria will not be paid to the President when acting as a member of the Board of Governors.
	2. Only one honorarium per day can be claimed by any individual. In the event more than one meeting is held in a day, the greater of the two amounts will be paid.
	 3. Board Honoraria Schedule A. The Chairman or person acting as chair shall be paid: a stipend of \$142.50 per month, \$66.50 per meeting of the Board of Governors or its committees that are 4 hours or less, and \$133.00 per meeting of the Board of Governors or its committees that are over 4 hours, and \$14.25 per hour spent traveling to and from meetings of the Board or its committees; the time spent is calculated by dividing the distance traveled by an average speed of 90 kph.
	 B. A member who is chairing a Board committee shall be paid: \$57.00 per meeting of the committee that is 4 hours or less, and \$114.00 per meeting of the committee that is over 4 hours, and \$14.25 per hour spent traveling to and from meetings of the committee; the time spent is calculated by dividing the distance traveled by an average speed of 90 kph.
	 C. A member shall be paid: i. a stipend of \$71.25 per month, or \$95.00 per month in the case of the Vice Chair,

	ii. \$49.88 per meeting of the Board of Governors or its committees that
	are 4 hours or less, and \$99.75 per meeting of the Board of Governors
	or its committees that are over 4 hours, and
	iii. \$14.25 per hour spent traveling to and from meetings of the Board or
	its committees; the time spent is calculated by dividing the distance
	traveled by an average speed of 90 kph.
	Note: "Board meetings" refer to meetings of the Board of Governors and
	subsequent committees, business meetings, committee meetings,
	conferences, Board of Governors approved retreats and workshops, and
	ceremonial events. (Reference: March 22, 2019 Motion 088-18/19)
	4. Community Education Committees (CEC) Honoraria Schedule
	A. CEC members shall be paid:
	i. \$60.00 for CEC meetings,
	ii. \$110.00 for Council of Community Education Committee (CCEC)
	meetings for a full day,
	iii. \$15.00 per hour spent traveling to and from meetings of the CEC; the
	time spent is calculated by dividing the distance traveled by an average
	speed of 90 kph.
	5. Board and CEC members shall be entitled to be paid traveling and living
	expenses as though they were College employees.
	6. Non-employee members of other committees established by the College may be
	paid on the same basis as CEC members.
	7. Members of the Board of Governors, Community Education Committees, and
	Council of Community Educations Committees may opt to transfer any or all of
	their portion of honoraria back to a Northern Lakes College student award.
	8. Members of the Board of Governors who are current employees of Northern
	Lakes College will not receive honoraria as prescribed in this policy for Board
	meetings that occur during standard hours of work when the College normally
	provides compensation. Members of the Board of Governors who are also
	employees will be eligible for the monthly stipend as prescribed-and travel
	honoraria as it occurs outside of standard working hours.
