 OR - AIT's Entrance Exam. Where "Pre-Employment" programs are offered, the applicants are reviewed by NLC for meeting the standards in the "Minimum Requirement" column.

RECOMMENDED PATH: Alberta High School Diploma with:

 • Math 30-3  
 • Physics 20 or Chemistry 20 or Science 20  
 • Related CTS courses • Attendance and participation in 'Introduction to Construction Trades.

- **APPLICATION:** Complete and submit the Northern Lakes College application available online on the college website at [www.northernlakescollege.ca](http://www.northernlakescollege.ca)).
- **APPRENTICESHIP EXAM:** Applicants needing to meet admission requirements must call the Alberta Apprenticeship & Industry Training office nearest to their location to make arrangements for writing the Apprenticeship Entrance Exam. (800) 248-4823
- **ACCEPTANCE:** Applicants who meet the requirements will be accepted and offered a space in the next available offering of the program. In some cases, the spaces at a specific location may be full and accepted applicants will be placed on a waitlist. These applicants will be accepted in the order of “first qualified, first served.” Applicants will receive a letter informing them of their acceptance status.
- **FUNDING:** Applicants are encouraged to check on funding options early (minimum of 2 months prior to program start date). AIT office or NLC counsellors can assist with identifying funding options and applying for sponsorship of fees and living costs.
- **REGISTRATION:** Before the start date of the program, accepted applicants will receive information about registration dates, times, locations and other information to assist them by email – please ensure we have an accurate email address for you.
