
Students are required to purchase their own textbooks for the courses they are enrolled in. Below, is a list of textbooks for **WINTER 2025**.



1 - Download & Log in to the NLC Connect App

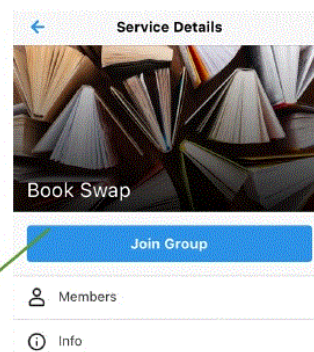
