

### **SOCIAL WORK DIPLOMA (Year 1):**


Students are required to purchase their own textbooks for the courses they are enrolled in. Below, is a list of textbooks for **WINTER 2025**.

Textbooks may come in printed or e-book formats, and some may have the option to be rented at a reduced rate. The Human Services department suggests students purchase the e-book version of texts. Hardcopy versions have different shipping times and may not arrive prior to the term start, which can make it challenging to catch up. If you choose a hardcopy version, ensure that the 13-digit ISBN is correct. Common websites used to purchase textbooks include, but are not limited to: Amazon, Indigo, or directly from the publisher (recommended – see publisher info in descriptions, below). Used copies of the correct edition may also be purchased. We have included the Book Swap Guide at the end of this document.




