

SOCIAL WORK DIPLOMA (Year 1):




Textbooks may come in printed or e-book formats, and some may have the option to be rented at a reduced rate. The Human Services department suggests students purchase the e-book version of texts. Hardcopy versions have different shipping times and may not arrive prior to the term start, which can make it challenging to catch up in the condensed spring term. If you choose a hardcopy version, ensure that the 13-digit ISBN is correct. Common websites used to purchase textbooks include, but are not limited to: Amazon, Indigo, or directly from the publisher (recommended – see publisher info in descriptions, below). Used copies of the correct edition may also be purchased. We have included the Book Swap Guide at the end of this document.

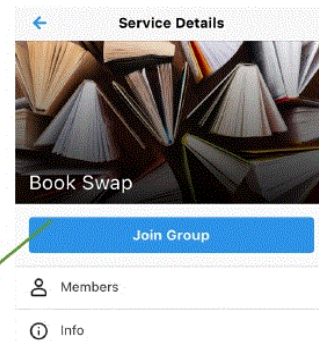
