



### **EARLY LEARNING AND CHILDCARE DIPLOMA PROGRAM:**

Students are required to purchase their own textbooks for the courses they are enrolled in. Below, is a list of all courses for this program and corresponding textbook information for **WINTER 2024**. It is highly recommended that students purchase books as soon as possible due to supply and demand and associated shipping times.

Textbooks may be purchased in two ways:

- 1) **E-book purchase.** The Human Services department suggests students purchase the e-book version of texts if available. E-books can be instantly downloaded and some may have the option to be rented at a reduced rate. Vital Source is one recommendation and some links are provided.
  
- 2) **Hard copy purchase.** Hardcopy versions have different shipping times. If you choose a hardcopy version, ensure that the 13-digit ISBN is correct.
  - Common websites used to purchase textbooks include, but are not limited to: Amazon, Indigo, or directly from the publisher (recommended – see publisher info in descriptions, below).
  - Used copies of the correct edition may also be purchased. We have included the Book Swap Guide at the end of this document.

\*The cover of novels may be different between vendors.




