


Students are required to purchase their own textbooks for the courses they are enrolled in. Below, is a list of all courses for this program and corresponding textbook information for **FALL 2024**.








STEPS TO JOIN BOOK SWAP WALL



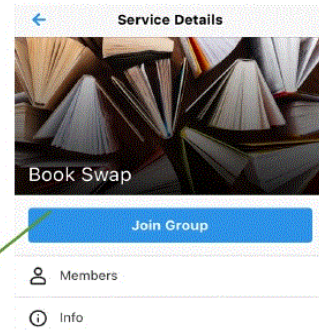
1 - Download & Log in to the NLC Connect App
