PROGRAM LENGTH: 45 hours per course

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Work from your home community and qualify for entrance into a post-secondary career of your choice! College and Career Preparation (CACP) courses are accessible, affordable, and convenient. The courses in CACP are intended to give you the skills you need for entrance into various Northern Lakes post-secondary programs. Classes are supported by an instructor and are offered anytime, anywhere for flexibility. If you have dreamed of taking any NLC post-secondary program, our courses can get you started!

Note: The courses above are not worth credits, but students must earn a passing grade (see specific program requirements) to be able to start their NLC program.

TRANSFERABILITY: Not applicable.

PROGRAM DELIVERY: The delivery method is anytime, anywhere, and paced. You may register in 1-4 courses in the fall or winter terms; three or more courses are considered full-time status in the fall and winter terms. During the spring, taking two courses is considered full-time. You may also complete all courses over 3 terms. This program is delivered online using the learning management system, Brightspace D2L. ENGL0190	pre-requisite:	Credit in any grade 10 English (10-1 or 10-2) or ACCUPLACER assessment
MATH0190	pre-requisite:	Credit in any grade 10 Math (except Math 10-4) or ACCUPLACER assessment
COMP0190	N/A	

Since you will be learning online, you will need to access to a computer, Internet, a calculator if taking MATH0190, and the textbook(s) or resource(s) assigned to each course. You may also access technology if they live close to any of the NLC campuses.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- APPLICATION: Complete and submit the Northern Lakes College application (on the college website follow: https://www.northernlakescollege.ca/apply-now/program-applications. Applications may also be submitted directly through Apply Alberta www.ApplyAlberta.ca. Applications should be submitted at least 2 weeks before term start date.
- TRANSCRIPTS: Provide an official high school and/or post-secondary transcript. This must be forwarded directly to Northern • Lakes College, Admissions Services, from the granting institution (there may be a charge for this). When transcripts are received at NLC, they are reviewed to determine if the academic requirements for admission to the program are met.
- ACCEPTANCE: Applicants who meet the academic requirements will be accepted and offered a space in the next available offering of the program. Applicants will receive a letter informing them of their acceptance status.
- **REGISTRATION & COMMITMENT FEE:** Accepted applicants in all career programs will be required to complete enrollment forms (to follow at a later date). This registration includes a \$100.00 (domestic student) or \$300 (international student) Commitment fee deposit. This fee is non-refundable & non-deferrable and will be applied to your tuition once the term begins. Payment in full will be required a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the program start date.
- FUNDING: Applicants are encouraged to check on funding options early (minimum 2 3 months prior to program start date) and are responsible for forwarding any sponsorship letters to Admissions as soon as possible. Part-time students of this program may be eligible to receive Learner Income Support through Government of Alberta, Human Services.
