WELCOME


At Northern Lakes College, we understand each student is unique. We offer an inclusive Supported Distance Learning (SDL) environment that caters to the needs of each and every student.





IT'S NEVER TOO LATE TO FOLLOW DREAMS



Selected as the valedictorian of the 2021 graduating class at Northern Lakes College, University Studies graduate, Jeri Asels-Beaulieu, has modelled grit, determination, and resiliency in her studies as she navigated family health scares over the last year.

"2021 was such a difficult time for my family! We got through it, and I'm so thankful for the support of my instructors. When my husband was admitted to the hospital, I was crying on the phone to my instructors, worried that maybe I wouldn't be able to complete the essays that were due, but they were really understanding. They gave me open deadlines and trusted in me. They just said, 'come back when you are ready to start working again.' I appreciated how NLC values family," explains Jeri.

Before enrolling in the Northern Lakes College University Studies program, Jeri worked in early childhood education for over ten years. She loved teaching preschool children, but dreamed of teaching older students. As Jeri states, "I was a working mother and unsure how I would access my education. After learning that NLC offers classes online, it suddenly made everything achievable for me."

Immediately thriving in her studies,
Jeri started working at an elementary
school where she met a veteran school
teacher, who soon became her mentor.
Jeri noted that the warm, welcoming, and
wise woman was the only Indigenous
teacher in the school, and that the young
students looked up to her. Jeri herself
valued seeing an Indigenous woman in a
position of leadership and influence.

"It was eye-opening to see that there were so many Indigenous children in the school, and yet there was only one teacher there who shared their culture. I learned that she was well into her years when she decided to become a teacher. That was my story, too. My mentor is the one who showed me that it's never too late to follow your dreams," Jeri explains.

When considering her future, Jeri's focus is on Indigenous youth. "Kids are growing up unaware of the histories of Canada's First Peoples, and there is loss of language and culture. That inspired me to be not only a teacher and a leader, but an inspiration to children. I hope to be a good role model," she explains.

Through a partnership with Northern Lakes College, Jeri has been accepted into the University of Calgary's Community-Based Bachelor of Education program, where she will pursue a specialization in Social Studies.



ENTREPRENEURIAL TRAINING



Northern Lakes College Business
Administration student, Glen Whitfield, received the opportunity of a lifetime when his instructor nominated him to participate in 90-Day Startup, a workshop for aspiring entrepreneurs. Participation in the training was made possible through Craig Elias, Entrepreneur-in-Residence at Bow Valley College, who supports business students studying at Alberta post-secondary institutions to become first-time entrepreneurs.

Glen originally began studying business in his twenties, but life happened and, before he knew it, almost ten years had passed. When Glen decided to resume his studies, he had a family to provide for. But his thirties also brought a discipline he hadn't known before. This can-do attitude and ability to organize time and prioritize tasks was of huge benefit during his intensive 90-Day Startup training. He explains, "It was a lot of learning, but the coaching and materials made me feel very confident when performing the practical experiments. The greatest benefit for me was the confidence I gained in starting a successful business out of nothing. I now know how to approach potential customers."

Glen's confidence was developed, in part, because of the dedication Northern Lakes College has to the success of students. Glen knew of the NLC reputation for supporting mature students through flexible schedules, and he chose the College so he could continue to work full-time night shifts while earning his certificate.

He elaborates, "Northern Lakes College has been phenomenal. Because of their support, I haven't missed a single day of work, except for a few I purposefully took off around finals. I feel like the NLC program is challenging, but at the same time I'm enjoying revisiting subjects for more context and clarity. I also can ask questions I might not be comfortable asking in the workplace. I feel more confident at work and in considering my future."



LENGTH

Two months of technical training for periods one through three, and three months of technical training for period four.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Electricians find employment with construction and maintenance contractors, manufacturers, resource companies, large organizations, or are self-employed.

WELDER APPRENTICESHIP

FACE TO FACE

If creating something out of metal is an art you would like to master, then welder is the trade for you. Welders specialize in the joining of metal components, working in commercial, institutional, and industrial settings.

LENGTH

Two months of technical training for each of the three periods.

Welders find employment in industries that involve heavy equipment repair, industrial construction, pipeline construction, structural repair, commercial construction, or are self-employed.



BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION DIPLOMA - MANAGEMENT

UNLINE

The Business Administration Diploma – Management program is offered in partnership with Portage College and focuses on the real-world applications of core business theories so you have the tools you need to effectively manage people, finances, production, and promotion.



ADVANCED CARE PARAMEDIC

BLENDED

This diploma program provides the entry-level knowledge and skills you need to practice emergency prehospital medical/trauma care and to function as a vital member of the health care team. Graduates will be able to perform the competencies identified in the National Occupational Competency Profile for Advanced Care Paramedics and will write a provincial registration exam.

LENGTH

Two years full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Upon registration with the Alberta College of Paramedics, graduates are eligible to work in rural, urban, clinical, or industrial settings, and with ground or air ambulance services.

FURTHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates may pursue degree completion at a later time in their careers. NLC has a two-plus-two-degree completion opportunity with Athabasca University and Thompson Rivers University.

PRIMARY CARE PARAMEDIC

RI FNNFN

The field of paramedicine offers you an exciting and rewarding career where you can make a positive impact in the lives of others. This program allows students to gain hands-on experience through labs and scenario-based training. Communication, personal wellness, safety, critical thinking, and professionalism are emphasized throughout the program. The flexible program schedule allows students to remain employed in their home communities while earning their credential.

LENGTH

One year full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Upon registration with the Alberta College of Paramedics, graduates are eligible to work in rural, urban, clinical, or industrial settings, and with ground or air ambulance services.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may begin their primary care paramedic education in high school by taking University Studies courses.

FURTHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Successful completion will allow graduates to work in entry-level emergency medical service positions and is a prerequisite for the Advanced Care Paramedic program.

HEALTH CARE AIDE

As a graduate of the Health Care Aide program, you can work as a vital member of the health care team, assisting regulated members in providing care to clients of all ages. Students are required to pass a provincial standard exam in order to receive certification.

LENGTH

Ten months full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Graduates have gained successful employment as a health care aide, health care assistant, and mental health aide.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may begin their health care aide education in high school by taking University Studies courses.

HEALTH CARE AIDE EMPLOYED STUDENT TUTORED EDUCATION PROGRAM (ESTEP)

BLENDED

If you are a non-certified health care aide seeking certification, look no further! This program allows employed students to gain additional work experience in a clinical setting that may be eligible for practicum credits. Successful graduates earn a Government of Alberta Health Care Aide Certificate.

LENGTH

Up to one year.

HEALTH CARE AIDE PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT AND RECOGNITION (PLAR)

NLC ANYTIME, ANYWHERE

This program is suitable for non-certified, experienced health care aides (HCA) who wish to receive recognition for their knowledge and experience. To obtain an HCA Certificate, a learner must obtain credit for nine courses (six theory and three clinical). As an experienced HCA, a learner may be eligible to obtain course credit through PLAR or by taking a full course.

PRACTICAL NURSE

BLENDED

Are you looking for a challenging and rewarding career in health care? The Practical Nurse program prepares you to earn a licence, enabling you to work as part of a health team. Practical nursing is a self-regulated profession with a unique body of knowledge, standards of practice, code of ethics, competencies, and a societal contract to provide safe, quality, and holistic patient care.

FULL TIME OR PART TIME

LENGTH

Two years full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Licensed practical nurses work in nursing care facilities, hospitals, physicians' offices, mental health, general care facilities, and home care.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may begin their practical nurse education in high school by taking University Studies courses.



Graduates may be eligible for acceptance into the Post-licensed Practical Nurse Bachelor of Nursing or Bachelor of Professional Arts programs at Athabasca University. Graduates are eligible to receive credits from Thompson Rivers University towards a Bachelor of Health Science or Bachelor of General Studies.

ADDICTIONS COUNSELLING DIPLOMA

The journey to addiction recovery requires the support of trained counsellors with knowledge and skills in the field. Graduates of this diploma program will have the skills to provide counselling to individuals, groups, and families. If you are interested in the field of addictions, are compassionate, and like to help others, this program may be a good fit for you!

AVAILABLE ANYWHERE FULL TIME OR PART TIME

LENGTH

Two years full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Addictions counsellors work in treatment and recovery centres, provincial health programs, family and youth centres, and women's shelters.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may begin their addictions counselling education in high school by taking University Studies courses.

FURTHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Some credits may be transferable into other NLC programs, such as Social Work and Practical Nurse. University credits are transferable to some post-secondary institutions in Alberta. Block transfer of this two-year diploma is available for entrance into year three of the four-year Bachelor of Health Sciences degree program at the University of Lethbridge.

EARLY LEARNING AND CHILD CARE CERTIFICATE

Would you like to be a positive influence in the lives of young people? Consider a career in early learning and child care. The Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) Certificate program will give you the training you need to work in this rewarding career. LENGTH

One year full time.

CAREER POTENTIAL

Graduates will qualify for Level 1 and 2 Early Childhood Educator certification under the Alberta Child Care Licensing Regulation.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may begin their early learning and child care education in high school by taking University Studies courses.

FURTHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates may be able to transfer into the ELCC Diploma program or apply 12 credits towards the Educational Assistant Certificate program, both offered at NLC. Graduates have 30 credits towards Athabasca University's Bachelor of Professional Arts, Human Services Major.


TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY




