The Board of Governors will consult with students on instructional and non-instructional student fees.

Objective:	To provide transparency of decisions around student fees through a consultation
	process with the Board of Governors.
Guidelines:	Northern Lakes College develops or revises tuition and mandatory non-instructional fees (MNIFs) in an open manner. The process:
	A. meets all requirements and guidelines of the Ministry of Advanced Education,
	B. assures compliance with the <i>Alberta Post-Secondary Learning Act</i> and <i>Tuition and Fees Regulations</i> , and
	C. ensures appropriate consultation and discussion with students.
	Consultation on student tuition and mandatory non-instructional fees provides students with information on key budget parameters and impact of student fee revenue on the quality of College programs and services. As delegated by the Board of Governors, the President & CEO will meet with the Students' Association annually in November for the fee consultation.
	1) In December, the Board of Governors will meet with the Students' Association for fee consultation.
	A. If further consultation is required, the Students' Association may present information to the Board of Governors at any time, by arranging through the Board Executive Assistant to appear as a delegation. In addition, the student nominated Governors represent a student perspective in the Board of Governors discussions on fees.
	2) All tuition and mandatory non-instructional fees are subject to the approval of the Board of Governors as required under the <i>Alberta Post-Secondary Learning Act</i> .
	3) The following fees are subject to the Alberta Tuition Framework:

	A. Tuition fees or fees for instruction
	B. Mandatory fees for materials and services that facilitate instruction at the
	program and/or course level except :
	 i) fees for equipment and materials retained or leased by the student including breakage fees,
	ii) fees for work placements for which provincial funding has not been provided, and
	iii) fees for travel for field trips and/or practicum.
	 iv) Learning Resource Fees are exempt from the Tuition Fee regulation as they do not represent a revenue stream for operations.
	All mandators non-instructional face are to cover only the consider provided
	All mandatory non-instructional fees are to cover only the services provided under those fees.
	C. New mandatory non-instructional fees will only be levied following
	consultation with the Students' Association.
	D. Each type of fee will be itemized separately.
	E. Fee objectives shall be clearly displayed.
	F. Wherever published, all mandatory non-instructional fees need to be clearly identified.
	G. Students can request additional institutional services and their willingness to pay for these services.
	4) These consultations do not include fees controlled by the Students' Association.
	Students' Association fees will be identified separately from institutional fees.
