APPLICATION ☐ First & Last name ☐ Email ☐ Date of birth ☐ Program name, and length. ☐ Start and end date of program for current academic year (usually September - April). ☐ Fees for program (tuition, Students' Association fee, tech. fee, books/LRF). ☐ Alberta Student Number (ASN) — found on your Alberta High School transcripts, or go to: https://learnerregistry.ae.alberta.ca/ ☐ Line 15000 from most recent tax assessment. ☐ NLC Student ID#	 □ Computer Cost can include expenses such as: software (Microsoft Office, etc.), hardware (new laptop or RAM), and/or the internet fees you will incur for the duration of your program. □ There is only one campus location listed on the online loan application – Grouard. Please select this option even if it is not where you will be attending. □ There is help every step of the way!
