	students, staff, and researchers, including provisions for joint ownership in
	collaborative projects.
	3. Disclosure:
	Implement a process for disclosing potential intellectual property to an
	appropriate office or committee within the institution.
	4. Commercialization:
	Provide guidelines for the commercialization of intellectual property.
	5. Dispute Resolution:
	Establish procedures for resolving disputes related to intellectual property.
