| Guidelines: | Decisions made under this policy shall adhere to the following executive limitations: 1. Consultation with key stakeholders and business areas must precede any significant operational or strategic changes to technology and its use. 2. Strategic technology directions will guide the technical or architectural |
| | design of the College. |
| | 3. All technology shall be managed to ensure the College's goals effectively. |
| | 4. Information must be managed throughout its lifecycle to ensure integrity, availability, and appropriate level of confidentiality regardless of format. |
| | 5. Industry standard frameworks for information technology management shall guide risk mitigation efforts. |
| | Information is a critical asset for decision-making and service delivery; the President & CEO, or a designated representative, will ensure strict information management. |
| | Access to information will be granted based on business needs and documented procedures. |
| | 8. Users must understand their responsibilities regarding privacy protection, information security, duty segregation, and identity management. |
| | College information integrity must be safeguarded against technological change. |
| | The President & CEO shall operate within financial, operational, and strategic constraints established by the Board of Governors, ensuring that decisions align with Northern Lakes College mission, vision, and values. |
| | Furthermore, the Board of Governors authorizes the President & CEO to delegate authority as appropriate. |
